Description of Major Special Funds

<u>Oscar F. Blackwelder Scholarship Fund</u> In memory of former pastor. Principal invested; investment returns to be used to aid seminary students.

<u>Choral Arts Endowment Fund</u> Broadly supports the rich choral life of the congregation, including the contracting of vocal and instrumental performers and associated costs. Eligibility for use of the investment returns generated by this fund is reviewed by the Worship Music and Arts Committee.

Erb Fund for Outreach Ministry Principal invested; investment returns used for outreach ministry.

Evien Fund for Homeless Ministry Principal invested; investment returns used for homeless ministry.

<u>Heckman Alto Fund</u> Established by Susan Blackman; investment returns used for alto section lead.

<u>Janssen Fund for Special Music/Talent</u> In memory of Ted Janssen. Principal invested; investment returns to be used to fund music and special talent at worship services.

<u>Janssen Fund for Visits to Shut Ins</u> In memory of Ted Janssen. Principal invested; investment returns to be used for ministry to shut-ins.

<u>Janssen Scholarship Fund</u> In memory of Ted Janssen. Principal invested; investment returns to be used to aid seminary students.

<u>Moeller Fund for Organ Maintenance</u> Established by Philip W. Moeller as a family memorial for his mother and father. Principal invested; investment returns to be used for the maintenance and repair of the pipe organ and to support the role of music in the spiritual life of the congregation. May also be used for piano tuning and repair.

Norment Fund for Property Maintenance Monies received from the estate of Cecil Norment. Remaining principal invested; investment returns to be used only for property maintenance.

<u>Florence Heckman Choral Fund</u> Established by friends of Flossie Heckman in 2018 in memory and in honor of her passion for Christ, her love of Reformation, and her beautiful voice. Supports an alto section lead.

<u>Sue Goetz-Ross Fund</u> Monies contributed by Steve Ross in memory of his wife. To be used to support Reformation's music program and the work of the Director of Music and the Arts in areas such as: special music, music library, use of professional artists/instrumentalists on a regular basis or for special occasions, and special musical events.

The Carrol Benner Kindel and Karl K. Kindel Fund Monies periodically contributed by the Kindels to support Southeast Ministry as the Reformation Church Council may determine for this purpose. The donors' intent is to support the programs of Southeast Ministry that provide employment, education, and training to low-income and vulnerable residents of Washington, DC. If Southeast Ministry ceases to function, the Council has authority to name a similar or complementary ministry or ministries to be the beneficiary/ies.

Pastor McNeill Outreach Fund Bequest from Reformation's former pastor. To be used for outreach.

<u>Laura Trexler Scholarship Fund</u> Bequest from Laura Trexler designated for seminarians from Reformation who attend Philadelphia or Gettysburg seminaries.

Endowments

Reformation Fund: Established by the Congregation Council in 1996, the Reformation Fund has received designated and undesignated bequests and gifts from members and friends of Reformation. Principal is invested by Wells Fargo Advisors. Income supports outreach in the community (33%), missions of the ELCA (33%), and capital improvements and debt reduction (33%). In 2020, donations were sent to global mission partners in Namibia, Jerusalem, and El Salvador and locally to Washington Interfaith Network.

Lyon Fund: Monies received from the estate of Robert Lyon. Principal is invested by Wells Fargo Advisors. The congregation initially voted to use the income for outreach, in particular, Southeast Ministry. The congregation can vote to change this designation and has done so as part of the budget process. In 2020, income was used for staffing and property.

<u>Taylor Fund</u>: Monies received from the estate of Mildred Leeke Taylor. Principal is invested by Wells Fargo Advisors and the ELCA Foundation. The donor designated the income to be used for outreach, with the restriction that it may not be used for mission support. In 2020, donations were sent to many organizations including Southeast Ministry, Homeless Children's Playtime Project, Everyone Home DC, and other global and local ministries. The fund also helped fund pastoral support for service and justice ministries.

Wells Fargo Advisors

The funds at Wells Fargo Advisors are invested in stocks and fixed income securities (typically bonds). Miller/Howard Investment, Inc. managed the stock portfolios through August 2020, when the manager changed to Calvert Atlanta, one of two managers recommended by Frank Key, Reformation's investment advisor. Calvert Atlanta is a leader in environment, social, and governance investing. ASG, a group within Wells Fargo Advisors, manages the fixed income portfolios. According to Wells Fargo, no bond investment manager in the industry uses social screens.

ELCA Foundation

The funds at the ELCA Foundation are invested in ELCA Endowment Fund A. According to the website, Fund A allows for the collective long-term investment of funds belonging to the ELCA and its affiliated ministries. Fund A follows, to the extent practical, the ELCA's guidelines for socially responsible investing, which discourage investments in companies that profit from the production of alcohol, military weapons and pornography, for example. Instead, it seeks positive social investments, directing capital to underserved markets, such as community development and renewable energy.
